

DARIO ACOSTA TEICH (2016)

Elegant classical guitar performances of South American folk songs, tangos and classic jazz standards.

TO FLY (2017)

Adventure meets spirituality and virtuosity in Acosta Teich's second solo album of classical guitar compositions inspired by his fundamental childhood dream: to be able to fly.

To Fly invites the listener on a fantasy expedition across musical landscapes that embrace Argentine folk traditions while venturing into avant-garde and jazz improvisation.

ALIEN (2021)

Nine fully improvised classical guitar pieces, including six original, expressing Acosta Teich's sense of dislocation, frustration and excitement as he navigates moving to New York City and the accompanying intense personal changes and challenges.

LATIN AMERICAN VERSIONS (2020 - 2021)

Latin American Versions is a series of duets with notable musicians around the world. This collaborative video/audio project was initiated by Acosta Teich for the purpose of shining light on the wealth of traditional rhythms from throughout Latin America and to bring them to broader audiences via broadly visible platforms such as YouTube.

FOLKLORE (2022)

Recorded at EastSide Sound in NYC.

Via this eight-track tour de force recording, Acosta Teich Quintet introduces audiences to unorthodox ways of playing traditional genres from Argentina drawing from jazz, avante-garde, and his deep connection to his Latin American folk roots. The project's founding musicians include Pablo Aslan (bass), Franco Pinna (drums), Julio Botti (sax) and Leo Genovese (piano). This album also features collaborators Eleanor Dubinsky (vocals), Jaques Morelenbaum (cello), Moto Fukushima (bass) and Zach Brock (violin).
